College (Autonomous), Puthanampatti, Tiruchirappalli – 621 007.**

Introduction

Exit feedback obtained from the UG and PG completed students and from M. Phil. and Ph. D. scholars when they come for their convocation ceremony. In fact it is obtained after one year of their course completion then only they could realise the worth of the course in our campus in their future career development.

Feedback content

The exit feedback also referred Students overall Evaluation of the Programme here after it will be referred as feedback which includes 20 questions to evaluate the programme which they underwent. Of the total 20 questions from one to 14th questions are objective types (70 per cent) with four scales and from 15th to 20th questions are descriptive types (30 per cent) which excluded from the analysis due to insufficient data available. The table 1 shows the weightage of the questions.

Within the objective type questions syllabus content was given more weightage (15 per cent to the total) followed by available reading material and hostel food and support service. Other aspects such as student evaluation, lab facilities, college facilities, extracurricular opportunities are given equal weightage (each 5 per cent to the total).

In the case of descriptive questions again syllabus content were given 20 per cent of weightage to the total and the rest are programme benefit and facilities in college are given 5 per cent each to the total.

Overall in both objective and descriptive questions highest weightage is given to syllabus content related questions which are 35 per cent to the total. Second priorities are given equal weightage of 10 per cent to benefit of the programme, hostel facilities, college facilities and available of reading materials. The least weightages are given equally (5 per cent each) to CIA, external evaluation, lab facilities, extracurricular opportunities, college office supports. In a nutshell curriculum related questions are given more weightage than the other aspects.

Methodology

Exit feedback forms (schedule) are circulated and collected from UG and PG students and M. Phil. scholars while they come to receive their degree at the Convocation function. After careful reading the student expressed their opinion by answering the questions both in objective and descriptive form. The feedbacks are obtained only the students who have attended the Convocation function at that year for example the 2015-2018 badge student would attend their Convocation during 2018-2019 academic years.

The present feedback report is based on five academic years of UG and PG students and M. Phil scholars from the academic year 2015-16 to 2019-20 (see table 2 for more details). The UG students' badge (ex. 2012-15) is also given in the same table. But PG academic badge is not given to avoid confusion. However, this report is based on two different academic year badge. The UG badge experienced three years and PG students have spent two years in their college (NMC) campus based on their experience they have revealed their Feedback. M. Phil. students experienced not less than a year from their admission until their thesis submission.

Table 3 gives a clear picture on universe (total no. of Feedback submission) and sample Feedback particulars to year wise and programme wise (see table 3 for more details). The sample size is fixed for 10 per cent of the total, however it exceeds due to weightage is given to less than 10 universe (ex. If universe is only one even that is taken for analysis, so that makes an excess of 10 per cent). Hence the grand total submission of Feedback is 4216 but the sample size should be 422 but actual grand total sample for the five years is 466. The total excess is 44.

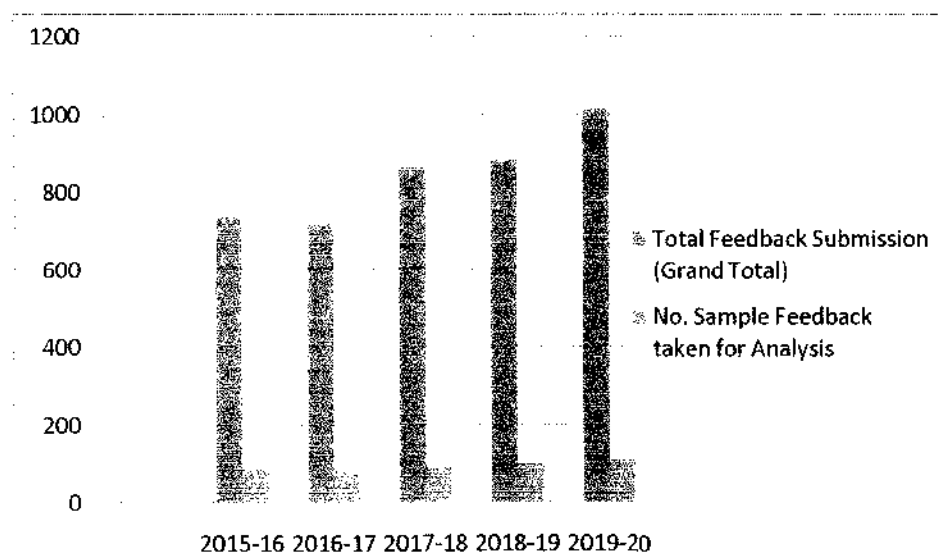

The feedback form is obtained every year at convocation function. From the collected feedback forms every year for the analytical purpose of the report five academic years from 2015-16 to 2019-20 was chosen. In each year total number of UG, PG and M. Phil programme wise total number of course is given (see table 4). In addition from each course total number feedback form as well as sample forms detail is also given in the same table.

The above four classified findings is given to entire college not to single course and single programme. It is the limitation of the Feedback report.

The feedback findings revealed that more than half of the total sample students (53 per cent) conveyed that they have more satisfied and nearly 40 per cent (47%) of the students opined that they have satisfied from the all aspects such benefit of the degree programme, syllabus, reading material available and access, CIA fairness and External evaluation quality, office support extracurricular activities, lab facilities, facilities provided by the college to day

scholar and hosteller. In these aspects there are 91 per cent of the students opined that from their experience as more satisfied and also satisfied. Only 4 per cent of the student have shown as not satisfied and 5 per cent feedback belong to cannot say categories. In a nutshell, the exit feedback of the student has shown that there is a positive experience in the campus while they studied.




available and access, CIA fairness and External evaluation quality, office support extracurricular activities, lab facilities, facilities provided by the college to day scholar and hosteller. In these aspects the cumulative per cent is 80. Only 8 per cent of the student have shown as not satisfied and 12 per cent feedback belong to cannot say categories. The exit feedback of the student has shown that there is more and satisfied experience in the campus while they studied (Table. 7).




