#### **Activities Report for 2018-2019**

#### Units –I,II,III,IV,&V

The NSS unit of Nehru Memorial College, Puthanampatti is continuously engaged in organizing various activities for its volunteers. The NSS volunteers have also shown a keen interest in participating in various programmes organized by NSS unit of Bharathidasan University under the guidance of Dr.A.laxshmiPrabha, coordinator NSS unit, Bharathidasan University, Trichy and our college NSS Programming Officers Prof. A.JAgadeesan, Dr.C.Prabhakaran, Prof. T.Prakash, Dr. V.Kaleeswari and Prof. S. Divyakannu.

- The NSS wing of the college organized campus cleaning in the regular activities include of weeds, plastics cups, tins, broken bottles, papers, broken tiles, tyres, dried leaves, clearing of bushes, destroying of creeps, waste materials etc. around the office premises, auditorium, laboratories, class rooms, library, dispensary, hostel blocks, playground etc.
- Our college, 30 NSS volunteers involved in the temple festival services at Abinimangalam.

- For the year 2018-2019, 250 first year students were enrolled for NSS on 17-10-2018 in Mookapillai Auditorium, Nehru Memorial College, Puthanampatti.
- The Annual Sports day celebration held at our college. In which around 50 NSS volunteers helped to the sports day function to get successful.
- Our college NSS volunteers planted saplings on the outside of MGCHostel on Nov 2018. About 25 saplings were planted.

**Objective:** To create awareness about dengue, its causes, symptoms and remedies

NSS unit Nehru Memorial College organized Dengue Awareness Campaign. The students were accompanied by the following staff coordinators Prof. A. Jagadeesan, Dr.C.Prabaharan, Prof. T. Prakash, Dr. V. Kaleesvari and Prof. Divyakannu. This awareness program was conducted in the neighborhood villages which includes Abinimangalam and Puthanampatti. The NSS volunteers took this opportunity to create awareness among the public about dengue and the Aedis Mosquito which causes the dengue.

Students visited each house and especially slum areas and created consciousness among lots of People who were unaware of these Dengue situations and also informed them about the Dengue fever, its severe effects and how to tackle these situations in an easy simplified manner so that they could remain safe. The students also requested the people not to leave the water to get accumulated nearby their residences.

The campaign covered around 100 houses in the neighborhood villages. This effort was highly appreciated by the public.



**Objective:** The main objective of this programme was to donate blood to people in need and to create awareness.

The NSS unit of Nehru Memorial College, Puthanampatti organized a blood donation camp in collaboration with Government Hospital, Trichy and Government Hospital, Thuraiyur on 06-07-2018 at Mookapillai Auditorium. The camp began at 10.00 a.m. with a short inaugural function. Dr. Velmurugan, chief surgeon, Thuraiyur and Dr. Solai Megala, Thuraiyur and his 17 member team was started the camp. Er.Pon.Balasubramaniyam, President, Nehru Memorial College, expressed his gratitude to the NSS unit of the college for its continuous endeavor in this regard. The Camp was inaugurated by Dr. A. R. Ponperiasamy Principal, Nehru Memorial College. More than 200 volunteers were participated in the blood donation camp and 100 volunteers came forward to donate blood during the camp which included students, teaching & non-teaching staff. Not only the NSS volunteers, our NCC cadets were also assisting and helping at the camp. Not only boys, even girls came forward and donated blood, eradicating the myth that girls are not strong enough to be donating blood. Overall, the camp was a novel way of addressing a national cause. At the end 92 units of Blood was collected. The blood donors were given water, Biscuits and frooti after donating the blood in order to reenergize themselves. The blood donors were provided with a blood donation certificate. The camp concluded at around 2.00 p.m.

This was the 1<sup>st</sup> camp conducted by the NSS unit for this academic year.
