#### REPORT

The **NSS Special Camp** of our college was held at Sirugudi, Kelappatti, Veerani, T. Kalathur and Elanthalaipatti from 12-02-2017 to 18-02-2017. The camp was inaugurated on 12-02-2017 by the special guest advocate **A.Thamilmani** delivered the special lecture on "**Current issues in our country**". - > During the 7 day camp, around 235 volunteers (140 Boys & 95 Girls) participated in the camp and it was organized by five Programme Officers.




