The Chairperson welcomed the members and informed them the necessity of revising the curriculum for **B.Sc Computer Science** from the academic year **2015-2016**. Then the chairperson permitted Mrs. R.Jaya, Assistant Professor in Computer Science, to present a brief report on curriculum development process made so far. Mrs.R.Jaya further informed that this is the 5th revision in sequence and a detailed comparative statement of curriculum designed during the academic years **2004-05**, **2005-06**, **2008-09** and **2011-12** was presented before the members. Then the feedback received from the Students, Alumni, Academic Experts and Industry Representatives were presented and perused by the members.

It is further informed that a sub-committee was constituted to discuss and frame the draft curricula. The sub-committee met on the following dates and held a detailed discussion on curriculum revision and finally prepared a detailed draft curriculum.

Then the draft curriculum prepared by sub-committee was placed before the pre-board of studies meeting conducted on **03-02-2015** and **16-02-2015** where the entire faculty members participated in the revision process and offered valuable suggestions. The faculty members had a fruitful discussion and finally prepared a draft syllabi and the same was placed before the **Board of Studies** for its perusal. The members perused the draft syllabi and a detailed discussion was made on the draft curricula. The suggestions proposed by the members in various suggestions/changes proposed by the members were listed as **Annexure I**. The members appreciated the effort taken by the faculty members and passed the following resolution unanimously.

Resolution No: UG/BOS01/2015:

It is resolved unanimously to approve the proposed revised curriculum for the **B.Sc. Computer Science** programme as per the common course structure in the CBCS pattern for the candidates to be admitted from **2015-2016**. The revised course structure and syllabus are enclosed in **Annexure II**.

Resolution No: UG/BOS02/2015:

It is resolved to introduce **internship** during the Vth Semester vocation on a trial basis. The students, who have completed the internship, may be given an extra **2 credits**

Resolution No: UG/BOS03/2015:

It is further resolved to offer the following courses as optional courses with 2 credits each.

Annexure -I

<u>Proposed suggestions/changes made in the draft curriculum by the</u> <u>Board of Studies in its meeting dated 20/02/2015</u>

- The Title 'Principles of Programming' may be changed as 'Programming in
 C'. The 4th and 5th Unit may be redistributed. Preprocessor directives may be shifted to 4th unit.
- 2. 'Data Analysis' lab may be renamed as 'Data Analytic' lab
- 3. 'Data Structure and Algorithm' redistribute unit IV into unit IV and V.
- 4. 'Data Base System', recommended to prescribe 'Silberschatz Korth Sudarshan' as a book for study, distributed data base shall be added as Vth Unit as suggested by Dr.N.Shenbagavadivu.
- 5. The nomenclature 'Database Lab' may be changed as 'RDBMS lab'
- 6. **'Computer system Architecture'** Dr. Abdul Razak suggested unit I may be allotted to digital design and remaining may be given to System architecture.
- 7. **'Programming in JAVA'** Prof .S.T.Rajan suggested that detailed descriptions of concept may be given in unit wise.
- 8. The Vth and VIth Semester Lab may be divided as two labs with 50 marks each.
- 9. In Core course Xa, 'TCP/UDP' may be removed
- 10. The name Web Programming shall be changed as Web Technology. The number of exercises shall be reduced based on number of hours.
- 11. The following exercises may be included in Hardware Lab.
 - (i). Assembly Language programs (ii). Networking Exercises (iii) OS Installation

- (iv) PC maintenance and trouble shooting.
- 12. It is further recommended to provide text book with latest edition and number of text books should be limited to two for each course.
- 13. It is recommended to have Computer Graphics, Software Engineering, Recent trends in IT as a Elective course I
- 14. It is recommended to have Rapid Application Development using Python, XML and Web Services, Distributed Technology as Elective course II.
- 15. It is further recommended 'Paulin Baker' may be prescribed as Text Book for Computer Graphics.
- 16. It is further recommended that in all language courses 20 % of the questions shall be problem oriented.
- 17. Prof.S.T.Rajan suggested that the board may consider C# programming course instead of C++ and the members felt that for at present C++ may be retained now.
