The syllabus proposals for PG – Economics – 15 Core Courses, 05 Elective Courses for the Semester I, II, III and IV respectively and the syllabus for M.A. Programme in Economics — for the students to be admitted from 2018-19 onwards were tabled before the Board. After in depth deliberations on issues concerning the syllabus, question paper pattern and the methodology to be adopted, the Board approved the syllabus proposals with necessary modifications and passed the following resolutions unanimously.
