NAAC SPONSORED TWO DAY ONLINE SEMINAR ON NATIONAL SEMINAR ON "QUEST FOR EXCELLENCE IN INNOVATIVE TEACHING WITH BLENDED LEARNING AND ROBOTIC EVALUATION SYSTEM"

Internal Quality Assurance Cell and Examination Cell of Nehru Memorial College, Puthanampatti organized a Two day National online seminar on "Quest for Excellence in Innovative Teaching with blended learning and Robotic Evaluation system" with the financial Assistance of National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bangalore from 12.08.2022 to 13.08.2022.

The seminar was conducted to provide a platform for academicians, educational experts and teachers to come together, re-assess and re-formulate best classroom practices by understanding and improving the processes involved in quality teaching-learning and evaluation. It is also an effort to produce a distinctive way of thinking about how teaching and evaluation in higher education. Totally 784 participants were registered and about 196 participants were actively participated through online meet and the program was telecasted through YouTube live stream mode.

The programme started at 10:30 am. Our College President, Er. Pon. Balasubramaniam, presided over the seminar. Our President outlined how our college fulfils former President of India, Dr. APJ. Abdulkalam's dream of PURA. Further he enlightened the importance of innovation in teaching and learning.

Our Secretary, Shri. Pon. Ravichandran felicitated the participants. Dr. A.R. Ponperiasamy, Principal, Nehru Memorial College has delivered presidential address. In his presidential address, he emphasized the need of excellence in innovative teaching and learning and evaluation.

Earlier, Dr. M. Mary Anbumathy, Controller of Examinations, Nehru Memorial College and convener of this seminar welcomed the gathering.

Dr. E. Ramganes, Professor and Coordinator of UGC SAP, Department of Education Technology delivered inaugural Address. In his inaugural address, he explained the need of new technologies in teaching, learning and evaluation. The inaugural function was ended with the vote of thanks of Mr. R. Kabilan, Assistant IQAC Coordinator.

In the first session, Dr. E. Ramganes, Professor and Coordinator of UGC SAP, Department of Education Technology gave a lecture on "Robust evaluation system in the light of National Education Policy. He discussed his experience in the creation of evaluation tools for higher education and underlined the need for innovative evaluation practices and reliable evaluation methodologies.

In the afternoon, the second session was started at 2.00 pm. Dr. Porgio Gabriel was the resource person and he delivered a talk on "Classroom strategies for Effective Learning" He nicely explained law of least effort, avoid overload information, Serial position effect, organization of information meaningful repetition, creating desire to listen, non verbal communication, multisensory approach and integrative reconciliation.

In the third session, Dr. G. Karthikeyan, Controller of Examinations, AVC College, Mayiladuthurai gave an informative talk on "Some Confidentiality and More Transparency: Essential for Examination and Evaluation". He explained the need of transparency in examination cell, confidentiality in and ethical principal of examination cell. He also explained why confidentiality is important and how it is maintained. He explained all with his own experience in his college.

On Day II, the fourth session started at 10.00 am with the talk of Dr. Charu Sheela Patil, Assistant Professor, Department of English, Sinhgad College of Arts and Commerce, Narhe, Pune on "Humanizing Education". She enlightened the development of the value of culture through education. She shared her efforts and experiments in humanising education. It focused on inculcating values and ethics. Furthermore, she gave suggestions for initiating the change in examination and evaluation.

The 5th session was started at 11.30 am. Dr. K.T. Tamilmani, Associate Professor and HOD of English, Nehru Memorial College, Puthanampatti was the chief guest and he gave a lecture on "Effective Learner Engagement with Blended Learning". Sir, Explained the is blended learning with examples with active discussion of participants.

The 6th session was started at 1.50 am. Dr. M.Muralidharan, Associate Professor and HOD of Computer Science, Nehru Memorial College, Puthanampatti gave a lecture on "Learning Management system a case study". Sir, Explained the digital classroom, learning management system and Google class room.

Dr. R. Nagarajan, Principal of AVC College delivered valedictory Address. In his valedictory address, he highlighted teaching, learning and evaluation, innovative teaching blended learning and student affairs knowledge.
